Why does pedestrian safety matter in Central Florida?

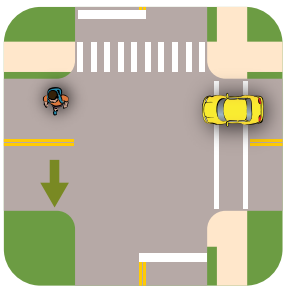
- 1) Ranked the “most dangerous” region in the nation for pedestrians for over 10 years.
- 2) Three people are struck by cars a day. (on average)
- 3) One person is killed each week crossing the street (on average).

It's time to put our Best Foot Forward.

We all have a role in making Central Florida a safer place for people walking. Best Foot Forward is a pedestrian safety initiative with a goal of convincing drivers to yield or stop for people in crosswalks. The program uses a “Triple E” approach of education, engineering and enforcement to convince drivers to obey the law – and yield for pedestrians! Let's all do our part by knowing and obeying the law and putting our best foot forward for pedestrian safety.

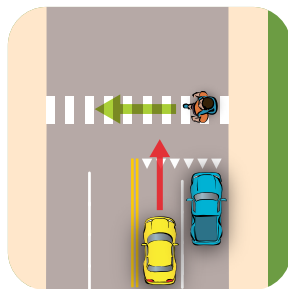


Florida Crosswalk Law F.S.(316.130)



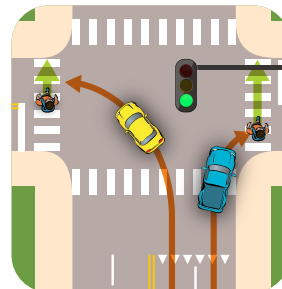
#1

Drivers must yield to pedestrians at intersections even if there are no pavement markings or signs.



#2

Drivers may not pass cars that are stopped at a crosswalk.



#3

Turning vehicles must stop for pedestrians at intersections with traffic signals.



#4

Drivers must come to a complete stop at crosswalks with signs indicating that a full stop is required.

Failure to yield = \$162 minimum fine + 3 points on your license
