FLORIDA CROSSWALK LAWS

Driver Offenses & Sections

316.130 (7) (b)

Failure to yield and stop at a crosswalk where signage so indicates

316.130 (9)

Overtaking a vehicle that has yielded at a crosswalk

316.130 (15)

Failure to exercise due care to avoid colliding with a pedestrian

316.075 (1) (a) 1

Failure to yield to a pedestrian when crossing lawfully in a crosswalk controlled by a traffic signal when turning facing a green indication

316.075 (1) (c) 1a

Failure to yield to a pedestrian when making a right turn on red

316.1301 (2) (a)

Failure to yield to a pedestrian crossing with a white cane or guide dog. All traffic must stop and the pedestrian need not be in a crosswalk.
